Canoeing/Kayaking Head

Along with meeting the expectations for, both, Ojibway Recreation Program Staff, and Ojibway Recreation Program **Head** Instructors, you will...

- Hold up to date, active ORCKA/Paddle Canada Instructor qualifications that will enable you to offer our campers the opportunity to earn the Basic ORCKA/Paddle Canada Canoeing levels from the first day of camp, onwards
- Complete necessary ORCKA/Paddle Canada paperwork in a timely fashion, thereby enabling campers to **receive** the ORCKA/Paddle Canada levels at our two Sports Award Dinners
- Be a competent, confident canoeist (both solo and tandem) and kayaker
- Be responsible for planning and delivering the Canoeing/Kayaking programming.
- Deliver programming that will help our campers earn their Basic ORCKA/Paddle Canada levels
- Complete all major planning **prior** to the opening of Camp, so that we have adequate time to organize/purchase/update necessary equipment
- Communicate equipment needs/issues promptly to Activities head/Recreation Head
- Work alongside the Activities Head to continually develop and improve the organization and delivery of any/all aspects of our Canoeing/Kayaking program
- Develop new ideas/ways to improve Ojibway's Canoeing/Kayaking program (e.g., a Recreation Program Canoe Trip/Overnight, etc...)
- Work alongside the 5 Head Counsellors to provide programming that is age appropriate. In order to do this, you must work collaboratively with our Counsellors and embrace new ideas and opportunities for development
- Be flexible and willing to adapt/modify programming as required (e.g., if the Seniors want to have a "Canoe Trip" themed week, you should be able to design lessons that relate to this theme)
- Work alongside the Activities Head to manage, address, and continue to improve the safety of the Ojibway Recreation Program's water activities

- Hold up to date ORCKA/Paddle Canada qualifications that will enable you to assist the Canoeing/Kayaking Head as he/she helps our campers earn Basic ORCKA/Paddle Canada levels from the first day of camp, onwards
- Help the Canoeing/Kayaking Head complete necessary ORCKA/Paddle Canada paperwork in a timely fashion, thereby enabling campers to **receive** the ORCKA/Paddle Canada levels at our two Sports Award Dinners
- Be a competent, confident canoeist (both solo and tandem) and kayaker
- Help the Canoeing/Kayaking Head plan and deliver the Canoeing/Kayaking programming.
- Assist the Canoeing/Kayaking Head as he/she delivers programming that will help our campers earn their Basic ORCKA/Paddle Canada levels
- Be aware of the planning the Canoeing/Kayaking Head completed **prior** to the opening of Camp, and, therefore, what is being organized for the upcoming summer in Canoeing/Kayaking
- Help the Canoeing/Kayaking Head communicate equipment needs/issues promptly to Activities Head/Recreation Head
- Work alongside the Canoeing/Kayaking Head to continually develop and improve the organization and delivery of any/all aspects of our Canoeing/Kayaking program
- Help the Canoeing/Kayaking Head develop new ideas/ways to improve Ojibway's Canoeing/Kayaking program (e.g., a Recreation Program Canoe Trip/Overnight, etc...)
- Help the Canoeing/Kayaking Head work alongside the 5 Head Counsellors to provide programming that is age appropriate. In order to do this, you must work collaboratively with our Counsellors and embrace new ideas and opportunities for development
